Carpark Safety

We are currently reviewing the safety of both car parks and are seeking advice on the best signage for our situation. Please follow some basic guidelines until we have a more formal process in place.

- Enter both car parks at walking speed
- Approach and proceed in a clockwise direction.
- Exit your car and walk children to the gate on arrival
- Exit your car to collect children at the end of the day
- Children must wait inside the gate
- Park well away from the gates
- Walk bikes from the carpark to the road at the busy end of the day.

West Car Park

- Do not park in the middle of the space but keep to the circular shape of the park
- Reverse park at the top end (South)
- Parallel park on the West side
- All vehicles to face down hill

Front of School

- All children who have not be collected at 4:40 will wait at the front of the school with bus travellers. Remember to keep the bus zone free of parking
- The speed limit is a permanent 40km zoned area
- Be extra careful when the buses arrive especially at the end of the day when student exiting the bus have to step on the road and our students are also on the road to enter the bus.
- Always exit your car rather than call children to you if you are parked on the opposite side of the road
